Task One:

Evaluate Your City

Introduction

Once you have prayerfully considered the idea of launching a City of Refuge, it is important that you carefully evaluate and assess the specific needs of your city. This process may take some time and patience but it is critical in regard to your ability to communicate the value of City of Refuge and attract the resources and people needed to successfully launch.

Questions to Answer

- Are there unmet vulnerabilities/needs in your zip code in homelessness, joblessness, education, health & wellness?
- Are there organizations (non-profit, government, etc.) currently serving in your area in homelessness, joblessness, education, health & wellness and are they serving with a holistic mindset? I.e. Is there a successful model currently in place?
- Is there history in your city/zip code that would prevent the COR model from being deployed successfully?
- Do you know of any potential financial investors with capacity, passion, interest in contributing?

Action Steps Complete before next session with City of Refuge Communities Team

Research available statistics on homelessness, joblessness, education, health & wellness in your zip code and outline in a document

Research all current providers of various services provided by City or Refuge (both for profit and non-profit) and present in a document

Identify 3-5 articles/white papers pertaining to the history of racial tensions in your zip code

Create a "Needs Statement" for your selected city / zip code

Develop a resident profile that outlines any available details related to the people you hope to serve
